

Year 3 Autumn Term. Through the Ages.

English	The children will be writing a setting description and a diary based up two Stone Age books, Stone Age Boy and The First Drawing. They will learn and apply the skills needed to write in these genres.	PE During the first term, the children will learn the skills and rules of Tag rugby. In term 2, the children will learn skills of dance and gymnastics.
Maths	We will begin this term looking at number and place value. We will then look at written formal methods for addition, subtraction and multiplication.	RE The children will look at belief through art and then they will look at light and dark, which focusses upon beliefs, festivals and cultures.
Reading	The children will learn and apply the reading skills needed to comprehend what they have read using fiction and non-fiction linked to the Stone Age.	Music Children learn what ballads are, how to identify their features and how to convey different emotions when performing them.
History/Geography	This term, the children will be learning about prehistoric lifestyles from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. They will learn about where and how people lived and how it compares to our lives today.	PHSE The children will be introduced to the zones of regulation and will learn how to personalise them to themselves.
Science	We will be learning about the importance of nutrition and making healthy choices as well as learning about the skeletons and the muscular system.	French The children will learn to say and spell who they are, colours, countries and numbers.
ICT	The term will begin with learning and using the PC's. They will then progress to programming and creating their own programmes.	Art/DT: In Art, the children will be looking at a range of prehistoric art and they will create their own cave painting using a range of natural materials.
