<p>Art at HFJS links closely to our overall topics in each year group. The children are taught to explore how mediums are used and to be curious about which techniques and skills underpin these outcomes. Mood Boards allow for children to explore themes, patterns and similarities and differences in relevant artists and to pose questions about underlying meaning and influences at the time.</p>	<p>Children will confidently evaluate and analyse creative works using the language of art, craft and design. Children will showcase their art work to peers and around the school, in the newsletter and to parents and be confident and proud in their own individual I style.</p> <p>Children are encouraged to analyse the strengths and weaknesses of their own and their peers work based on the skills taught and the impact of the final piece.</p>	<p>Through the use of their sketch books, children will explore different ways of using mediums and develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space and composition.</p> <p>Children will produce creative work, exploring their ideas and recording their experiences. Children have the freedom to explore their own take on projects and use different mediums according to their creative intention.</p>

<p>Children will learn about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work. They will know about the great artists, craft makers and designers, and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms.</p>	<p>Children will rework, improve and develop skills taught within and across year groups in Art throughout their time at HFJS. They will be aware of their progress and limitations and be able to choose which skills they needs to work on to improve their learning.</p>
